ROB STARR MEMORIAL BURSARY (1 - \$1,000)

Eligible applicants: students from ranching families to further his/her education in whichever field they desire. Complete one application for any of the above awards.

1. Applications for this Bursary will be received at any time prior to **April 15th**.
2. Applicants must be planning to enter (or return to) post secondary education within the 12 month period following the application deadline.
3. Financial need is a qualifying criteria. Please provide an outline of your budget for the next year (include a list of your expenses and sources of funds employment, awards, assistance from family, personal savings, etc.)
4. A student who has won one of these awards in previous years is not eligible to win an award in subsequent years.
5. The Cattlemen's Martin Riedemann Society is empowered to:
 - grant this bursary at its discretion;
 - withhold this bursary in any year if there are no eligible applicants, or for any reason deemed good or advisable.
 - agriculture related field of study may be considered a priority by the committee.
6. The awards will be payable on receipt by the Society of documentation confirming acceptance into the institution for post secondary education.
7. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
