## **SCHEDULE 5**

### **[REDACTED] Forest District Range Improvement Authorization AUTHORIZATION TO CUT CROWN TIMBER**

Pursuant to Section 43 of the Range Planning and Practice Regulations, you are hereby authorized to cut Crown timber in the process of authorized fence building and maintenance/protection operations under the following conditions:

1. Authority is granted for the area shown on the attached map.
2. All interests, rights, and privileges granted in this authorization are to be construed as subject always to all provisions of the *Forest Act*, the *Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act*, the *Forest and Range Practices Act*, and the *Heritage Conservation Act*, pursuant regulations, and amendments thereto.
3. Prior to the commencement of the actual operations on the area, the contractor shall submit a Notification of Commencement to the designated Forest Officer/Official at the [REDACTED] Forest District office to confirm the date of commencement and/or interruption of operations.
4. No new landings or roads are to be constructed without Forest Officer/Official approval.
5. Any existing fences damaged during logging operations conducted by the holder shall be repaired by the holder, at his/her own expense to the satisfaction of the Forest Officer/Official.
6. Culturally Modified Trees (CMTs) may be present. During felling of trees, reserve any CMTs from harvest.
7. Forest Officer/Official may require decking of merchantable timber.
8. The right of way shall not exceed the width authorized in SCHEDULE 8 attached to this authority.
