All Qualified Fencing Contractor quoters are required to attend the viewing. Project works includes:

Project #1: Buckskin Lake Replacement

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **740 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #2: Ducks Unlimited Dam Site Replacement

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **1,846 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #3: Park Fence Replacement

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **2,850 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #4: Buckskin Repairs

- Fence Line Repairs of approximately **120 meters** and **Two Fire Guard Breaches** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #5: Springfield Replacement

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **1,100 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.
