The review team expects the letters will not exceed two pages in length. **All applications must be received in the office of the society by March 1<sup>st</sup>**. The applications will be reviewed and winners announced by the end of May. These bursaries are designed with rural B.C. students in mind, and provided by the cattle industry.

**Your letter of application should describe your:**

- **involvement and/or interest in the cattle industry in BC.**
- **education plan and career goals.**
- **community involvement and volunteerism in your community.**
- **involvement at school, and your achievements.**
- **Comments on how you plan to finance your education. Financial need is a qualifying criteria. It is suggested that you include an estimate of your annual expenses and you should have considered tuition/books, living rent/food, travel/entertainment expense.**
