The BCCA PDI will be accepting Request for Quotes for the upcoming Provincial Range/Fire Fencing Program, fencing in the area of Chasm located in the 100 Mile Natural Resource District. All Qualified Fencing Contractor quoters are required to attend the viewing. Project works includes:

#### **BCCA PDI Project Number: M1704 Meadow Lake**

##### **Project #1: Meadow Lake Removal and Replacement**

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **2,000 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.
- Approximately 500 meters subject to monitoring.
- Approximately 200 meters of “No Blade” area located on fence line.

##### **Project #2: Meadow Lake New Construction**

- New Construction of approximately **4,100 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

##### **Project #3: Cattle Guard Installation**

- Purchase and Install Cattle Guard as indicated on the map.

**Fence viewing is mandatory** and will be held on **December 10, 2020**. Meeting time will be **10AM** with a marshaling point at the junction of Meadow Lake Rd and Hwy 97. If a representative will be viewing on your behalf, written notification must be sent to the office listed below, via fax or email prior to the viewing. Probationary contractors must attend the site visit in person, no alternate parties can represent the probationary contractors.

Completion date for the **BCCA PDI Project Number: M1704 Meadow Lake** will be **July 31, 2021**.

**Please ensure you are aware of the Coronavirus Screening Process:**

**Each person attending work must be asked 5 questions:**
