# COMMITTEE MERGER & SPECIAL ELECTION

**MERGER:** The Livestock Industry Protection Committee and the Research Committee are merging to create a new committee with a new mandate that will reflect the changing needs of industry.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All members in good standing, including those who have already served on LIPC or RES, are eligible for nomination & (re)election.

**TERMS:** Odd numbered zones (1,3,5,7) will elect for a 2-year term and even numbered zones (2,4,6) will elect for a 1-year term in 2021.
