Project #1: McLean Lake North Replacement (MCL – 4)

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **3,000 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #2: McLean Lake North Replacement (MCL – 5)

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **1,730 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #3: McLean Lake North Replacement (MCL – 6)

- Fence Line Removal and Replacement of approximately **1,687 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.

Project #4: McLean Lake North Removal (MCL – 6,8)

- Fence Line Removal of approximately **5,200 meters** of Four Strand Barbed Wire Fence.
